



WRESTLING FOR ALL Partners Program

PROPOSAL SPECIFICATIONS

This program is structured to support the strategic priorities of the National Wrestling Hall of Fame over the next four years. The goal of these priorities is to increase interest and participation in the sport of wrestling across all generations, while leveraging the brands of our partnering sponsors, and the National Wrestling Hall of Fame to ensure a future we all envision for the sport.





PROPOSAL SPECIFICATIONS

We have named this program "Wrestling For All" to highlight the diversity and inclusion the sport embodies. The funding goal for the Wrestling For All educational outreach initiatives is \$250,000 per-year investment over a four-year period from 2021-2025, for a total of \$1 million.

PROPOSAL SPECIFICATIONS

To achieve the *Wrestling For All* goals, the Hall of Fame is seeking donor and sponsor investments at the level of: \$5,000, \$10,000, \$15,000, \$20,000 or \$25,000 per-year, over the next four years.






AUGMENTED REALITY

DAN GABLE UNIVERSITY








TRAVEL EXHIBITS

Youth Challenge program to be integrated across all *Wrestling For All* platforms that will test the physical and mental attributes necessary to be a good wrestler.


Youth Challenges will be available online, allowing coaches and teachers the ability to administer the tests and record their wrestlers and students results online.


\$25,000 Annual Investment

\$15,000 Annual Investment






ACHIEVEMENT CERTIFICATE


